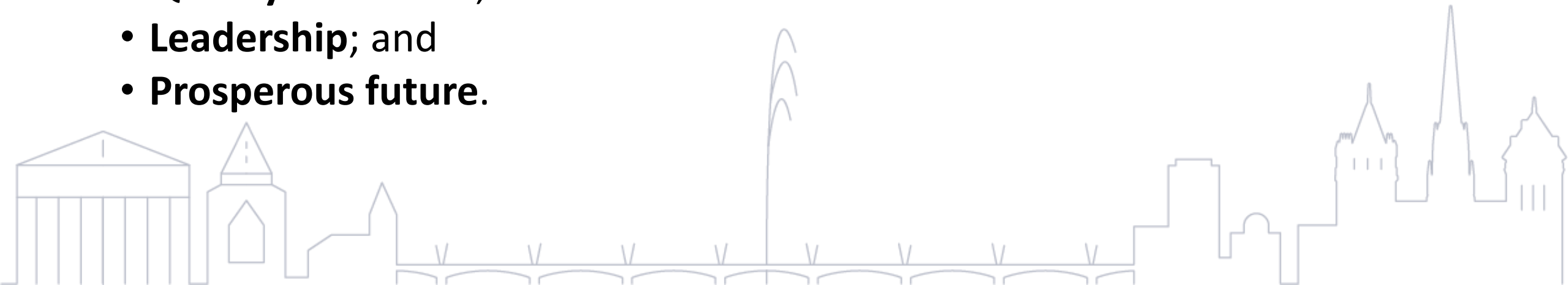

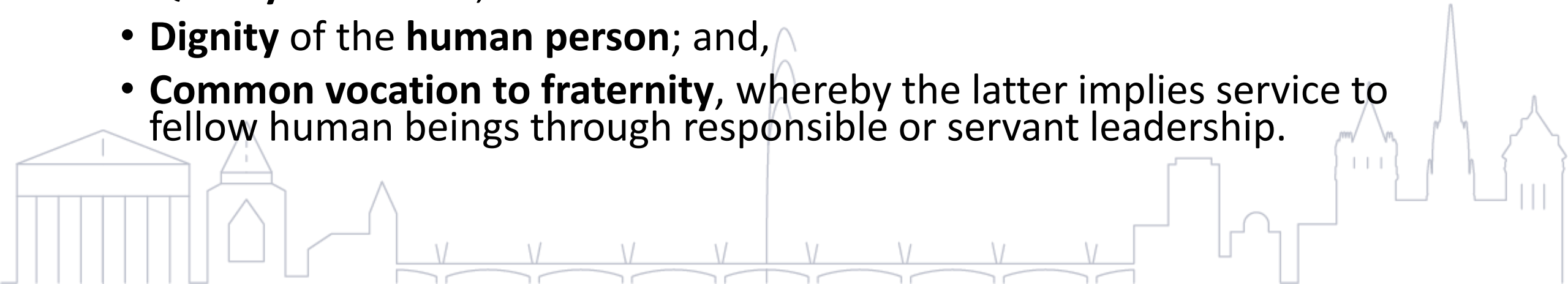
Introduction: Finding the Links

- **Prosperous future.**



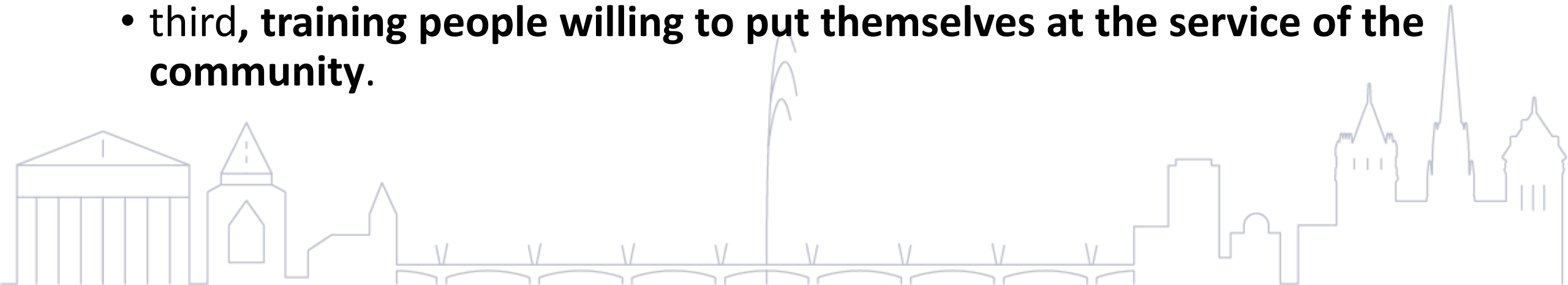
Introduction: Finding the Links

- In Oct 2020, Pope Francis made a passionate call for a Global Compact on Education. In this invitation, the call was and still is “to ensure that everyone has access to a **quality education** consonant with the **dignity** of the **human person** and our **common vocation to fraternity**.”
- **THREE** key components stand out:
- **Quality education**;
- **Dignity** of the **human person**; and,
- **Common vocation to fraternity**, whereby the latter implies service to fellow human beings through responsible or servant leadership.



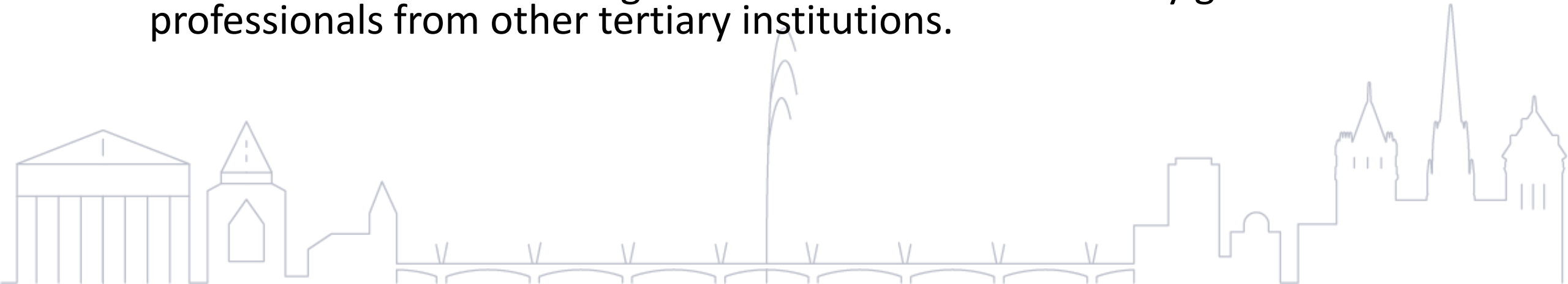
Introduction: Finding the Links

- Here we find **THREE** important dimensions of education, namely:
- First, **putting the person at the centre of every educational process;**
- second, **investing the best energy for an education of quality for all;** and,
- third, **training people willing to put themselves at the service of the community.**



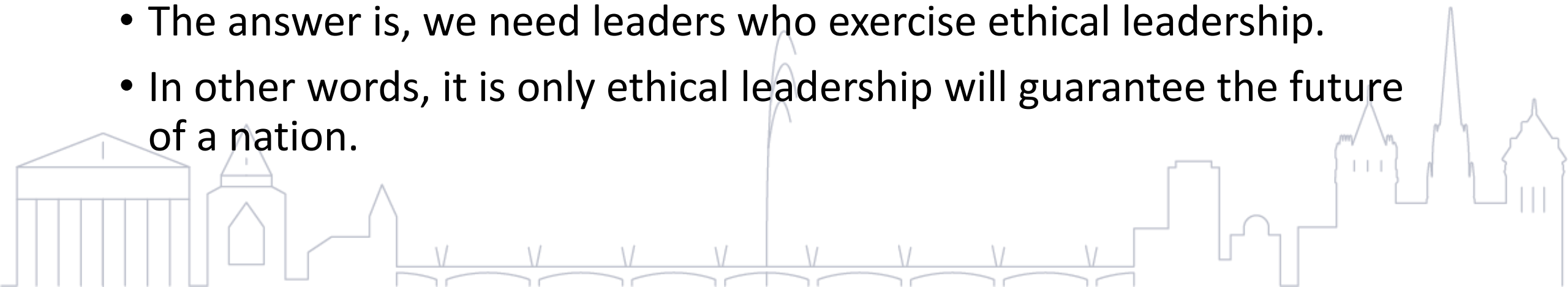
ii) Gaps and Challenges

- The Question that seeks an answer today is: Is our **education system** shaping **leadership** that can guarantee a promising **future**?
- There are **social, cultural, economic, political, religious** and **environmental concerns**, that are causing different **forms of human suffering**, hence, frustrating desire for prosperous future.
- Most of the leaders causing such frustration are university graduates and professionals from other tertiary institutions.



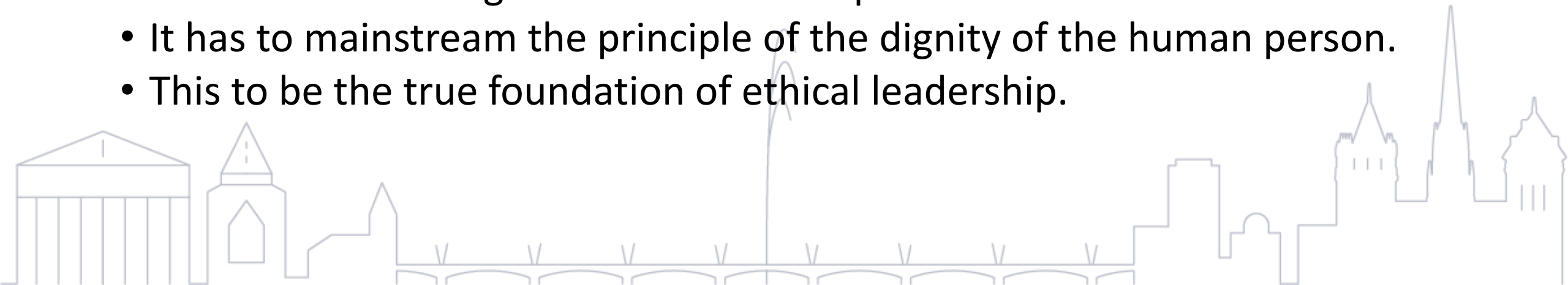
iii) Need for Transformative Leadership

- We need leadership that would guarantee a prosperous future.
- However, the major question that should come in our mind is: What is required in order to meet this standard of a leadership that brings the desired prosperous future?
- The answer is, we need leaders who exercise ethical leadership.
- In other words, it is only ethical leadership will guarantee the future of a nation.



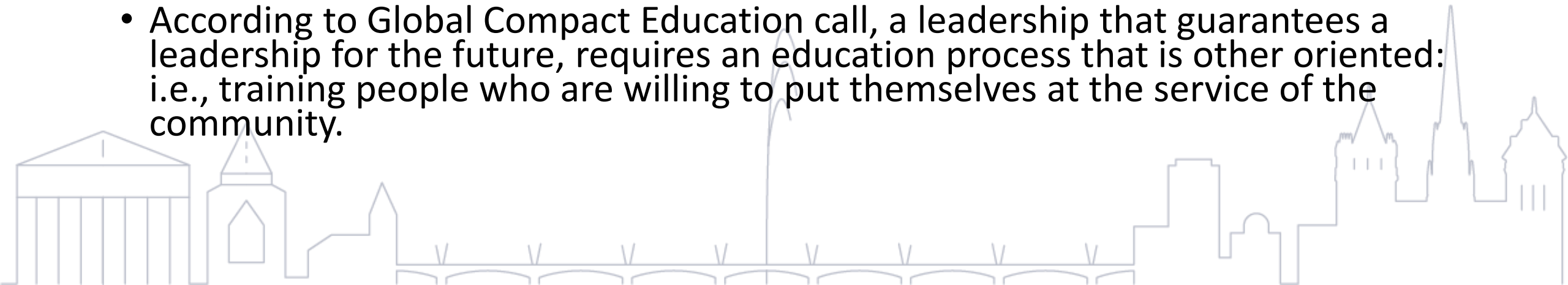
v) The Principle of the Dignity of the Human Person

- Leadership is offered by different professionals, who are products of our educational processes.
- Education has to be personalistic in nature and approach, in order to respond to the need for ethical leadership.
- Education that is personalistic in nature and approach has to have a clear understanding of who the human person is.
- It has to mainstream the principle of the dignity of the human person.
- This to be the true foundation of ethical leadership.



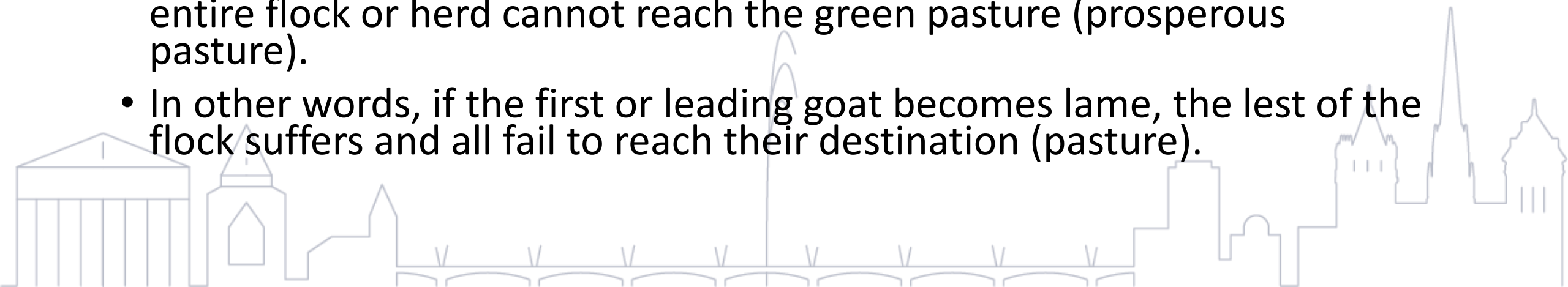
v) Human Dignity and Ethical Leadership

- Ethical leadership is one that basis its decision-making process on ethical reasoning, theories and values, that are inspired by the centrality of the human person in society.
- In other words, ethical leadership is a leadership that is person centred.
- This is a leadership that puts the other in perspective in all its decisions and actions.
- According to Global Compact Education call, a leadership that guarantees a leadership for the future, requires an education process that is other oriented: i.e., training people who are willing to put themselves at the service of the community.



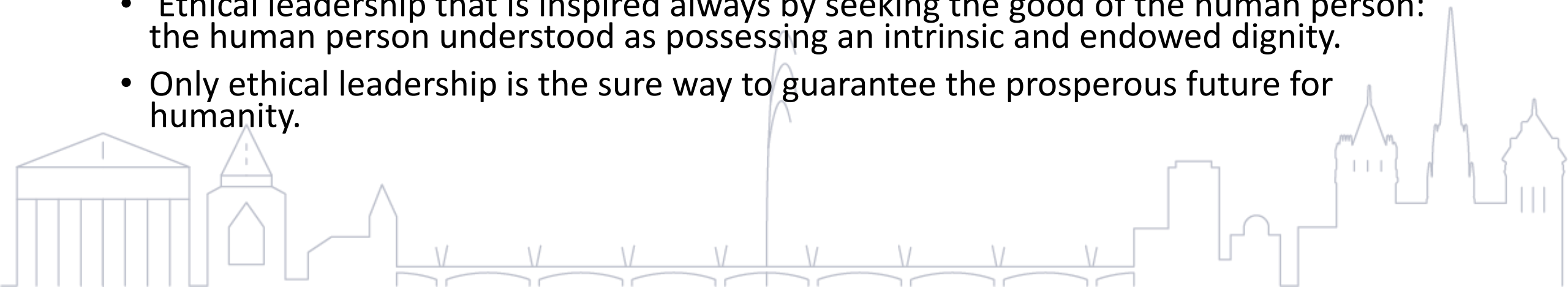
vi) Relationship between Ethical Leadership and Prosperous Future

- Leadership is everything for a prosperous future, or otherwise, of any human community and its various projects and programmes.
- The *Agĩkũyũ* community have the proverb that says: “irĩ gũthua ndongoria itikinyagĩra nyeki” and if transliterated, it means that when the leading sheep or cow in a flock or a herd suffers and it limps, the entire flock or herd cannot reach the green pasture (prosperous pasture).
- In other words, if the first or leading goat becomes lame, the rest of the flock suffers and all fail to reach their destination (pasture).



Conclusion

- We have affirmed that, as proposed by Global Compact on Education, education has to underscore the centrality of the human person in its nature and approach.
- Eventually this education will produce, as its product, an ethical leadership which will guarantee a prosperous future.
- This has to be firmly based on the true and solid foundation, namely: the principle of the dignity of the human person.
- Ethical leadership that is inspired always by seeking the good of the human person: the human person understood as possessing an intrinsic and endowed dignity.
- Only ethical leadership is the sure way to guarantee the prosperous future for humanity.
