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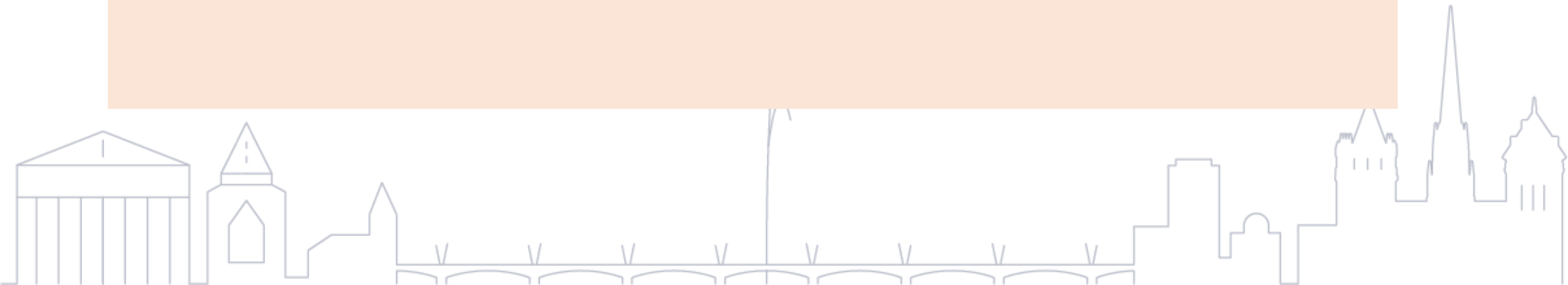

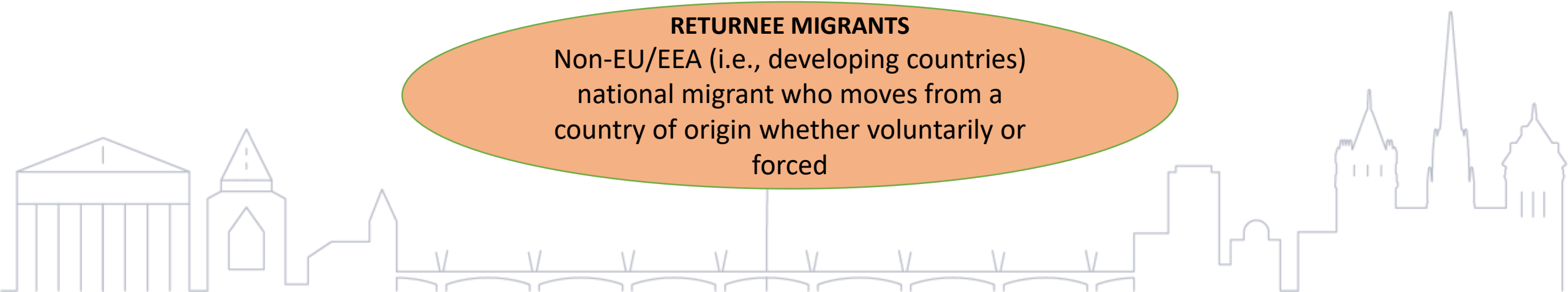

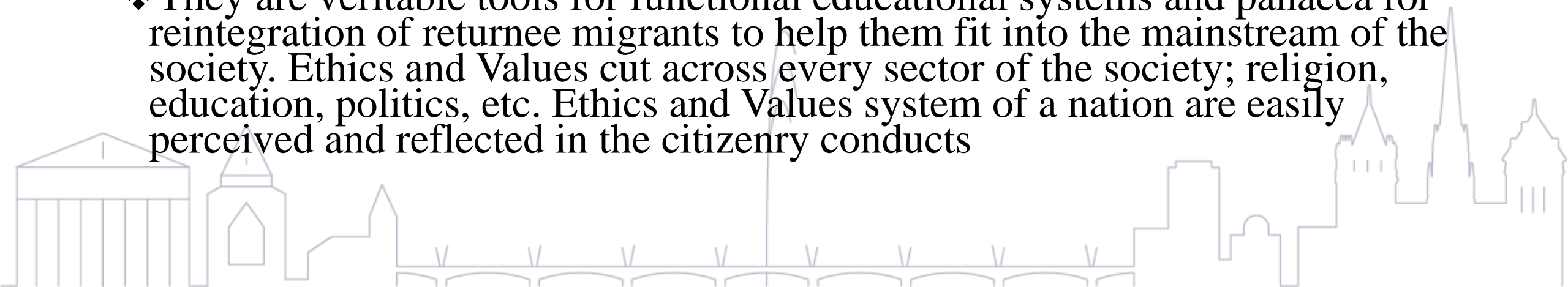
RETURNEE MIGRANTS

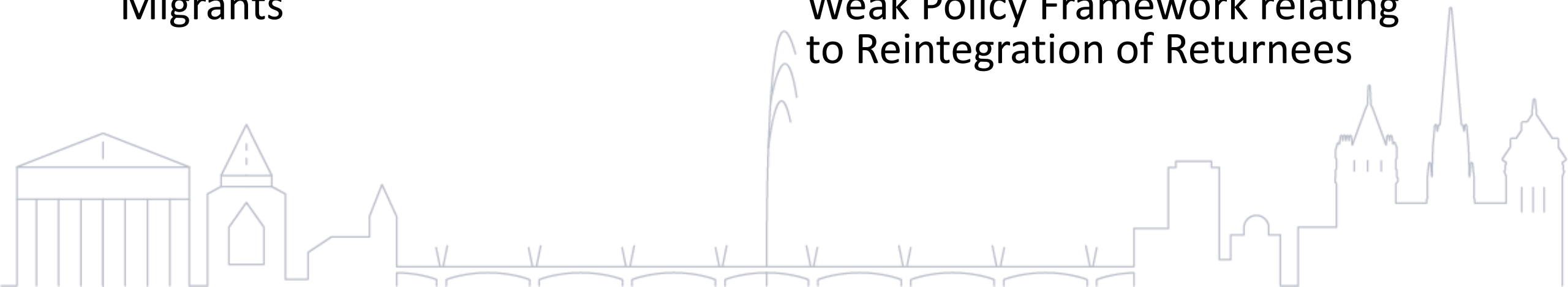
Insincerity in planning and implementing government educational policies
